
We are pleased to provide a letter of support for the Germany Road Relocation Project, PIK-CR66-05.65.

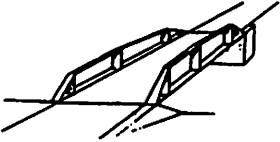

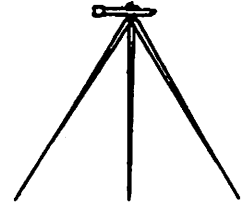
